EXTRAORDINARY MEASURE

The Ministry of Health, as the competent administrative authority pursuant to Section 80(1)(g) of Act No. 258/2000 Coll., on Public Health Protection and amendments to Certain Related Acts, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “Act No. 258/2000 Coll.”), orders this Extraordinary Measure, proceeding pursuant to Section 69(1)(i) and (2) of Act No. 258/2000 Coll., to protect the population and prevent the occurrence and spread of COVID-19 caused by the novel SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus:

Effective from 17 November 2022, the Extraordinary Measure of the Ministry of Health of 18 November 2021, Ref. No. MZDR 47828/2020-31/MIN/KAN, is amended in that:

“I.

Effective from 12:00 a.m. of 17 January 2022, all healthcare service providers that perform examinations to stipulate the presence of the SARS-CoV-2 virus using RT-PCR tests are ordered to perform examinations to stipulate the presence of the SARS-CoV-2 virus using RT-PCR tests on the persons specified in Art. II, who participate in the public health insurance system in the Czech Republic, if they request the performance of an antigen test and present their insurance ID card or substitute document, but no more than five times per calendar month.”
