



RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

No. 249 of 18 March 2020

on the adoption of an emergency measure

Following Government Resolution No. 194 of 12 March 2020, through which the government, in accordance with Sections 5 and 6 of the Constitutional Act No. 110/1998 Coll., on the security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency in the meaning of Section 5(a) through (e) and Section 6 of Act No. 240/2000 Coll., on crisis management and on the amendment of certain laws (Crisis Act), as amended, due to the health risks related to the proven incidence of coronavirus (referred to as SARS CoV-2) in the Czech Republic, the government has decided to adopt crisis measures in accordance with Section (5)(c) and (e) and Section 6(1)(b) of the Crisis Act in order to manage the current crisis situation.

The Government

prohibits, with effect from 12:00 a.m., 19 March 2020, the presence of all persons in retail grocery stores between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., with the exception of persons over the age of 65 years and the owners and employees of the store operator or persons in a similar relationship.
