

RESOLUTION
OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

Adopting an Emergency Measure

In relation to Government Resolution No 194 of 12 March 2020, whereby the government, in line with Articles 5 and 6 of Constitutional Act No. 110/1998 Coll., on the Security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency for the Czech Republic, due to a threat to health in relation to the documented occurrence of a coronavirus designated as SARS CoV-2, and in line with Section 5(a) to (e) and Section 6 of Act No 240/200 Coll., on crisis management and amending certain acts (the Crisis Act), as amended, to address the current emergency situation, has decided to adopt an emergency measure, pursuant to Section 5(1)(e) and Section 6(1)(b) of the Crisis Act,

The government hereby

I. Prohibits

1. Effective from 14 March 2020 at 6:00 a.m. through to 24 March 2020 at 6:00 a.m., retail sales and sales of services in establishments, with the exception of shops selling:
 - foodstuffs
 - computer and telecommunication equipment, audio and video receivers, consumer electronics, devices, and other household products;
 - automotive fuel;
 - heating fuel;
 - hygienic goods, cosmetics, and other druggist goods;
 - pharmacies and points dispensing medical products;
 - small domestic animals;
 - feeds and other articles for animals;
 - spectacles, contact lenses, and related goods;
 - newspapers and magazines;
 - tobacco products;
 - laundry and dry-cleaning services;
 - sales via the Internet and through other remote means;

where such goods and services are the predominant goods or services on sale or on offer at the establishment concerned;

2. Effective from 14 March 2020 at 6:00 a.m. through to 24 March 2020 at 6:00 a.m., the presence of the public at establishments offering dining services, with the exception of establishments not serving the general public (e.g., staff dining, dining for healthcare and social services providers, penal institutions); this prohibition shall not apply to sales for consumption outside of the dining establishment (e.g., fast-food establishments with dispensing windows or take-out foods where the customer does not enter the establishment), which can operate without restriction as to time;

3. Effective from 14 March 2020 at 6:00 a.m. through to 24 March 2020 at 6:00 a.m. the operation of dining service establishments located in shopping centres with a sales area in excess of 5,000 sq m;
 4. Effective from 14 March 2020 at 6:00 a.m., the operation of gambling points and casinos pursuant to Act No. 186/2016 Coll., on gambling, as amended.
- II. Effective from 14 March 2020 at 6:00 a.m., paragraphs I.2 and I.3 of Government Resolution No 199 of 12 March 2020 shall be rescinded.
