

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

of 12 March 2020 No. 201

on the adoption of crisis measures

Following up on Government Resolution No. 194 of 12 March 2020, through which the Government, in accordance with Section 5 and Section 6 of Act No. 110/1998, on the security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency within the meaning of Section 5(a) through (e) and Section 6 of Act No. 240/2000, on crisis management and on the amendment of certain laws (Crisis Act), as amended, due to the health risks related to the proven incidence of coronavirus (identified as SARS CoV-2) in the Czech Republic, the Government has decided to adopt crisis measures within the meaning of Section 6(1)(b) of the Crisis Act in order to address the current emergency.

The Government

I. prohibits with effect from 13 March 2020

1. the personal presence of pupils and students at elementary, secondary and higher college education at schools and educational facilities pursuant to Act No. 561/2004, on preschool, elementary, secondary, higher college and other education (Schools Act), as amended, and at events organised by these schools,
2. the personal presence of students in collective forms of education and examinations in relation to higher education pursuant to Act No. 111/1998, on higher education institutions and on amendments to other laws (Higher Education Act), as amended; personal presence is however permitted at clinical and practical training and work experience,
3. the personal presence of pupils at elementary artistic education at elementary art schools and language education at language schools with the right to conduct state language examinations pursuant to Act No. 561/2004, on preschool, elementary, secondary, higher college and other education (Schools Act), as amended, and at events organised by these schools,
4. the personal presence of persons in education in one-year foreign language attendance courses at institutions registered in the list of educational institutions providing one-year foreign language attendance courses pursuant to Act No. 117/1995, on state social support, as amended.
5. the presence of children, pupils, students and other participants in non-formal education at educational facilities for non-formal education, at competitions and shows organised for children, pupils and students of schools and educational facilities pursuant to Act No. 561/2004, on preschool, elementary, secondary, higher college and other education (Schools Act), as amended, and at events organised by these schools.

II. cancels the extraordinary measure of a general nature of 10 March 2020, Ref. No. MZDR 10676/2020-1/MIN/KAN as of 12 March 2020.
