

**RESOLUTION**  
**OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC**  
of 12 March 2020 No. 200

**on the adoption of crisis measures**

Following up on Government Resolution No. 194 of 12 March 2020, through which the Government, in accordance with Section 5 and Section 6 of Act No. 110/1998, on the security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency within the meaning of Section 5(a) through (e) and Section 6 of Act No. 240/2000, on crisis management and on the amendment of certain laws (Crisis Act), as amended, due to the health risks related to the proven incidence of coronavirus (identified as SARS CoV-2) in the Czech Republic, the Government has decided to adopt crisis measures within the meaning of Section 6(1)(b) of the Crisis Act in order to address the current emergency.

**The Government**

**I. prohibits**

1. with effect from 12:00 a.m. of 14 March 2020, all carriers in international passenger road transportation, organised using vehicles with an occupancy of more than 9 people, from transporting passengers over the border of the Czech Republic,
2. with effect from 12:00 a.m. of 14 March 2020, all carriers in international passenger rail transportation from transporting passengers over the border of the Czech Republic.
3. with effect from 12:00 a.m. of 14 March 2020, all carriers in cross-border domestic waterways transportation from transporting passengers over the border of the Czech Republic.
4. with effect from 12:00 a.m. of 14 March 2020, all carriers from using any airports other than the Vaclav Havel Airport (Prague/Ruzyně, LKPR) international public airport for commercial air transportation with passengers on board, during which the border of the Czech Republic is crossed;

**II. allows**

1. citizens of the Czech Republic and foreigners residing in the Czech Republic with temporary residence of more than 90 days or permanent residence, who are returning to the Czech Republic, to return to the Czech Republic via international occasional passenger road transportation organised using vehicles with an occupancy of more than 9 people,
2. foreigners to leave the Czech Republic via international occasional passenger road transportation organised using vehicles with an occupancy of more than 9 persons,
3. carriers in international passenger road transportation based in the CR, as well as carriers based outside the CR, to transport empty buses without passengers

to/from the Czech Republic.

4. carriers in international passenger rail transportation based in the CR, as well as carriers based outside the CR, to transport empty trains without passengers to/from the Czech Republic.
5. carriers in cross-border domestic waterways transportation based in the CR, as well as carriers based outside the CR, to transport empty vessels without passengers to/from the Czech Republic.

**III. stipulates** that exceptions from this extraordinary measure may be granted by the minister of transport.
