



RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

of 12 March 2020 No. 194

The Government, in accordance with Art. 5 and 6 of Act No. 110/1998, on the security of the Czech Republic,

declares

in the territory of the Czech Republic, due to the health risks related to the proven incidence of coronavirus (identified as SARS CoV-2) in the Czech Republic, a

STATE OF EMERGENCY

starting from 2:00 pm on 12 March 2020 for a period of 30 days.

The Government

I. o r d e r s within the meaning of Section 5(a) through (e) and Section 6 of Act No. 240/2000, on crisis management and on the amendment of certain laws (Crisis Act), as amended, crisis measures to address the current emergency, the precise implementation of which the Government will stipulate in a separate Government Resolution;

II. i n s t r u c t s

1. the prime minister to manage and coordinate the tasks pursuant to point I;
2. the members of the Government to request the Government for prior consent to measures related to the declaration of a state of emergency, which each member of the Government or the ministry managed by them shall perform within their capacity, before their application;

III. the valid extraordinary measures of the Ministry of Health issued to date are not affected by this declaration of a state of emergency;

IV. this decision comes into effect on 12 March 2020 at 2:00 pm and will expire upon the passing of 30 days from its date of effect;

V. c h a r g e s the prime minister to inform the Chamber of Deputies of the Czech Republic forthwith about the declaration of a state of emergency pursuant to point I of this Resolution.
