CANCELLATION OF EXTRAORDINARY MEASURE

The Ministry of Health, as the competent administrative authority, pursuant to Section 80(1)(h) of Act No. 258/2000 Coll., on Public Health Protection and amending certain related acts, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “Act No. 258/2000 Coll.”), proceeding pursuant to Section 69(1)(i) and (2) in conjunction with Section 94a(4) of Act No. 258/2000 Coll.,

I.

cancels the extraordinary measure of 6 March 2020, Ref. No. MZDR 5503/2020-12/PRO.

II.

This cancellation of the extraordinary measure takes effect on the day of its issue.

Rationale:

Under the extraordinary measure of the Ministry of Health Ref. No. MZDR 5503/2020-12/PRO of 6 March 2020 (hereinafter referred to as the “extraordinary measure”), all parties were prohibited from selling all class FFP3 personal protective equipment pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/425 of the European Parliament and of the Council, manufactured and marketed pursuant to technical standard EN 149:2001+A1:2009, to parties other than the Czech Republic, its organisation units and distributors of the said personal protective equipment, which can only resell or transfer the said personal protective equipment to the aforementioned parties in accordance with the extraordinary measure.

Pursuant to Section 94a(4) of Act No. 258/2000 Coll., it applies that if the reasons for issuing the general measure pursuant to subsection (2) were to pass or change, the public health protection authority will immediately cancel or change the measure.

Because the government of the Czech Republic has on this day issued a government resolution on the adoption of a crisis measure pursuant to Section 6(2)(f) of Act No. 240/2000 Coll., on Crisis Management and on the amendment of certain laws (the Crisis Act), as amended, under which it ordered the specified manufacturers to prioritise the Ministry of Health when supplying the class FFP3 personal protective equipment pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/425 of the European Parliament and of the Council, manufactured and marketed pursuant to technical standard EN 149:2001+A1:2009, the necessary supplies for the Ministry of Health have been secured by other means with a lesser impact on the market with the said personal protective equipment. For this reason, the Ministry of Health has decided to cancel the extraordinary measure with immediate effect.
